Baptist Care SA aims to be as accessible as possible. We will do our best to support you if you let us know what assistance you require.

What are my transport/parking options for getting to and from Baptist Care SA?

Baptist Care SA is located at 130 Rose Terrace, Wayville, S.A. (opposite the Adelaide Showgrounds). While there are no accessible car parks in front of the Baptist Care SA office, there are unmarked accessible car parks available at 134 Rose Terrace. Please call ahead on 8273 7100 to reserve an accessible car space. This carpark has sealed concrete and is approximately 100 metres from the front entrance of the Baptist Care SA building. There is free 2 hour on-street parking on the streets surrounding the Baptist Care SA and a car park with casual rates is also available on Rose Terrace opposite Baptist Care SA. Taxi drop off can be organised at the front entrance and our staff can call for a taxi on behalf of attendees.

Public Transport

If you are coming from the city, catch the Seaford train from Adelaide Railway Station to the Adelaide Showground Railway Station (a six minute ride) and walk or wheel 220 metres up Rose Terrace to Baptist Care SA. Alternatively, catch the Bus W91, 265, 167C or G10 from the city. Check Adelaide Metro for further details.

Accessibility at Baptist Care SA

There are sealed pathways to Baptist Care SA and wheelchair access to the front entrance. To enter the building there is a buzzer to the left of the front door with an electric sliding door. Immediately to the right is a lift to Level 2 where there is a high level reception desk. All visitors must sign in. If required, reception staff can assist with the sign in sheet. Most public activities are located on the second floor.

An accessible toilet is behind the reception area to the left (through the kitchen area). Chairs are used in an open space that can be arranged in different ways to accommodate access requirements- so please let us know your space and seating requirements. While a Hearing Loop is not used, we can use microphones and speakers if required. Assistance animals are welcome.
