Standard Activities		
Activity	Description	Ideal Age Range
Horse Riding	 Have a ride on one of our horses & learn how to work with them to create a mutual understanding/relationship. Start with the basics of riding on a horse that is handpicked to suit the rider, then build up to completing harder steering challenges. After establishing communication with the horse at a walk, participants can experience the faster trot. Horse riding is a great opportunity to push the boundaries of comfort with a connective reward. 	10 years +
Horsemanship	Interact with our amazing horses up close and personally whilst learning horsemanship skills such as grooming, handling, and feeding. A perfect opportunity to gain a deeper understanding in the ways horses think, interact, and communicate with both humans and each other. This program is ideal for particpants to gain confidence, respect and awareness for these large animals whilst allowing for deeper connection between campers and the natural world.	8 years +
Sheep Herding	Sheep Assisted Learning is an activity designed to challenge teamwork skills, encouraging strategic practices and communication focus. This activity creates a great opportunity for participants to use their problem-solving skills to herd sheep around obstacles and into the desired location. This can lead to some very unorthodox methods which can be highly entertaining.	Any age
Archery	Archery offers the opportunity for particpants to try a new skill and to improve throughout the session. Our unique and quirky Archery Range has a variety of targets that are less common in traditional archery and makes for an interesting and exciting experience.	Year 5+
Bushwalking	Wirraway has over 180 acres of scenic farmland, which includes heritage area, a winding creek, diverse Flora, and spectacular views. Various survivals skills are taught, such as: starting a fire, snake safety and getting lost in the wild! Bushwalking is a well- loved activity where participants can challenge themselves and learn new skills in a picturesque environment.	Any age
Low Ropes	Low Ropes Course is designed for participants to test their speed, agility, balance, thinking, communication, and teamwork. Whether it's swinging from rope to rope, climbing walls, or balancing along a log. This fast-paced course allows particpants to work as a team to compete in a time trial, where typically the team with the best strategy and preparation will be victorious.	Year 3+ (weight/height restrictions)

Activity Descriptions

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Wirraway / Homestead

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Additional Activities		
Shelter Building	Lost in the wilderness with no shelter, no sign of civilisation and a big storm coming within the hour! Shelter Building provides a challenge to construct a shelter that would comfortably sleep a participant for a night. Their shelter must be wind proof and waterproof. This activity is great to give participants the chance to utilise the resources in their environment, but they must be quick because it is highly likely that they could get wet!	Any age
Amazing Race	Race around Wirraway in teams searching for clues and answering questions. Learn about the history of Wirraway, utilising critical thinking, problem solving & teamwork skills. Which team will complete the challenges & finish first.	Any age
Whip Cracking & Lassoing	The aim of this activity is to teach participants how to safely crack a whip and have a fun Australiana experience. Mastered the Cattleman's Crack? Have a go testing to see how many cracks the participant can attempt in a minute or how accurate the participant can be whipping off our targets. Then move onto lassoing where the participant can test lariat skills & lasso targets.	Year 5+
Eggstronauts	You've heard of Astronauts, but have you heard of Eggstronauts? Testing a team's creativity and teamwork participants will have to work together to build a rocket ship out of supplies. With some great engineering and a touch of creativity and colour this rocket ship will have to stand the test when it is launched up and out into the paddocks, hopefully the Eggstronauts survive the trip! Long Range Archery	Having mastered the skill of Archery at our Archery Range, participants test their accuracy and strength aiming long range. Participants will try and shoot their arrows all the way up and across the paddock or see what targets they can hit along the way	Year 7+
Pool & Raft Making	Weather permitting the outdoor pool is used in activity time for participants to have fun swimming, relaxing, and playing games in under the supervision of a qualified pool lifeguard. Participants will be split into teams, strategize, build & race with Raft Making!	Any age

Excalibur	Fun, large, interactive WIDE game set in Medi Eval times where Houses compete against each other for the ultimate glory.	Any age
Night Games	Participants compete in teams in various night games including capture the flag, ghille suits & tug of war!	Any age
Prison Break	Campers play as 'Escapees' and must escape from jail and move from safe house to safe house working as a team through hostile territory patrolled by "Security Guards".	Year 3+
Night Hike	Students hike the Wirraway Paddocks and learn about their surroundings and stars!	Year 3+
Quiz Night	Questions will be divided into various categories including TV, Film, Sports, Geography, General Knowledge, Astronomy, and a special Wirraway round.	Year 3+
