OUR SERVICES



Supported Independent Living

Our team helps clients requiring higher levels of support to live independently by supporting them to manage everyday tasks, to develop social, relational and communication skills and participate in sport and recreational activities. Supported Independent Living clients have the option of a Support Worker stay overnight.



In-Home Supports

Our team supports clients to manage everyday tasks such as cooking, cleaning, and budgeting, to develop social, relational and communication skills and participate in sport and recreational activities.



Developmental Education

Our team works with clients to develop skills, increase independence, become connected with community and achieve goals.

Through education, learning strategies to increase independence, behavioural modification, sensory regulation, and collaboration with other allied health professionals, we support clients to develop social, self-help, and daily living skills, and manage challenging behaviours.

We offer support to families and caregivers by providing strategies and resources, emotional support and advocacy.



Occupational Therapy

Our team works with clients to participate in meaningful day-to-day activities that improve health and wellbeing.

Through education and the development of self-care skills, we support clients to develop emotional control, concentration and sensory processing which supports participation in meaningful daily activity and life roles. We complete one-off functional capacity assessments and can develop building capacity plans for people of all ages.



Positive Behaviour Support

Our team works with clients to explore why challenging behaviours occur and learn to develop alternative behaviours.

We start by understanding the reasons behind challenging behaviours, such as communication difficulties, sensory sensitivities, or unmet needs.

Then we provide appropriate training that supports clients to develop alternative behaviours by learning more effective ways to communicate, manage emotions and interact with others. We may also modify environments, including physical surroundings and daily routines, so they are more accommodating and supportive.
